April-June Requirements:

- Register as a AYSO volunteer at www.eayso.org and file 2 copies of signed paperwork with AYSO board members
- Complete On-line Safe haven Certification at www.aysotraining.org (you will need your AYSO ID #; check with your coordinator if you need help finding this information) (Approx. 30 minutes in length)
- Complete Intermediate coach training by taking the following classroom/field classes:

For INTERMEDIATE training you must take **all** FOUR components (two class and two field)

Fri 5/14	INT class	6-10pm	Foster City Rec (Mist room)
Sat 5/15	INT field	9am-3pm	Bowditch (Foster City)
Sun 5/16	INT field	9am-1pm	Bowditch (Foster City)
Sun 5/16	INT class	1-3pm	Foster City Rec (Gull room)

If the course dates are out of the question for you, talk to your coordinator about possible alternative dates.

July Requirements:

- Attend a mandatory Coach meeting at the end of the month where you will receive your team uniforms, sign up for your practice times and receive other useful information (Approx. 1 hour in length)

August Requirements:

- Contact your team and begin practices the week of 8/16 (a 1.5 hour practice, 1 day a week for approximately 14 weeks)
- Conduct a parent meeting (suggested at end of first practice)

September-October requirements:

- Attend Opening Day parade (Saturday, Sept. 11 at 8:15 am at BHS stadium)
- Attend 9 games scheduled throughout the two month period (80 mins. in length) and 2- 4 post-season play games for championship title
- Provide player evaluation to the division coordinator at end of season coaches meeting
