### April-June Requirements:

- Register as a AYSO volunteer at [www.eayso.org](http://www.eayso.org) and file 2 copies of signed paperwork with AYSO board members
- Complete On-line Safe haven Certification at [www.aysotraining.org](http://www.aysotraining.org) (you will need your AYSO ID #; check with your coordinator if you need help finding this information) (Approx. 30 minutes in length)
- Complete U8 coach training at [www.aysotraining.org](http://www.aysotraining.org) (Approx. 30 minutes in length)
- Attend one field session course (4 choices offered) Date and time: TBA
- Take AYSO referee course (1 day course)

### July Requirements:

- Attend a mandatory Coach meeting at the end of the month where you will receive your team uniforms, sign up for your practice times and receive other useful information (Approx. 1 hour in length)

### August Requirements:

- Contact your team and begin practices the week of 8/16 (a 1 hour practice, 1 day a week for approximately 12 weeks)
- Conduct a parent meeting (suggested at end of first practice)

### September-October requirements:

- Attend Opening Day parade (Saturday, Sept. 11 at 8:15 am at BHS stadium)
- Attend 9 games scheduled throughout the two month period (50 mins. in length)
- Provide player evaluation to the division coordinator at end of season coaches meeting
